LEADERSHIP ADDRESS

As we reflect on the past fiscal year, Project QUEST proudly declares that we have soared to new heights! Our unwavering dedication to our community and the individuals we serve has propelled us to achieve unprecedented levels of engagement and service throughout the San Antonio region. This milestone year also marked the completion of our inaugural year of the groundbreaking Ready to Work program. We are pleased to report that Project QUEST is performing above expectations and continues to deliver on our commitment to the success of this program.

Through the tireless efforts of our committed and skilled staff, Project QUEST has reached a new pinnacle in the number of participants served. We successfully enrolled 1,065 new individuals, providing support and Coaching to a total of 2,359 participants. Guiding 861 towards graduation, we achieved a remarkable feat by placing 515 participants into transformative careers in key industries such as Healthcare, Information Technology, and Trades. Notably, those placed experienced a significant increase in their annual earnings, soaring from an average pre-QUEST wage of \$15,553 to an impressive verified post-QUEST average wage of \$46,648—an extraordinary 200% increase! The combined impact of these placements injects an astounding \$24 million back into the San Antonio community.

This year, Project QUEST has made a significant increase in our depth and breadth of our nationally recognized wraparound model. Project QUEST successfully secured funding to introduce two pivotal roles: a Social Worker and an Alumni Relations and Career Transitions Coordinator. In doing so, we have positioned ourselves to be better equipped to address the pressing needs of the social and emotional well-being of our participants and recognizing the importance of supporting our alumni on their ongoing professional journeys. With the addition of these roles, we have not only elevated our capacity to serve our participants but also solidified our lifelong commitment to QUESTERS.

In looking ahead, Project QUEST is poised for continued success and growth. The achievements of this fiscal year serve as a foundation for our ongoing commitment to creating meaningful impact in the lives of those we serve. As we celebrate our achievements, we also look forward to the future, where our passionate and talented staff, supported by the guidance of our dedicated Board, will continue to change lives. The support of our key partners and funders remains crucial to the continued success and growth of Project QUEST. We extend our deepest gratitude to every individual and organization that has played a pivotal role in the success of our mission.

OUR EFFORTS THIS YEAR HAVE RESULTED IN SEVERAL SIGNIFICANT ACHIEVEMENTS

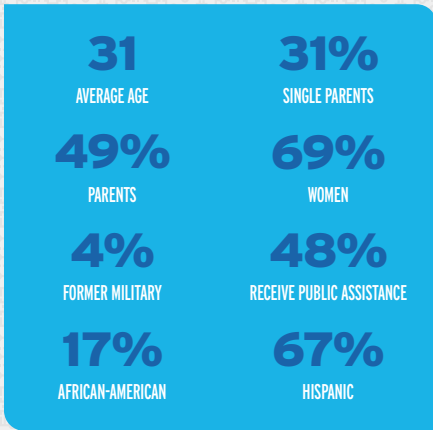
- We delivered our nationally recognized wraparound model to a record number of participants, with nearly 2,400 individuals served this fiscal year.

- QUEST graduates placed in jobs made a substantial impact of approximately \$24 million injected back into the San Antonio community.

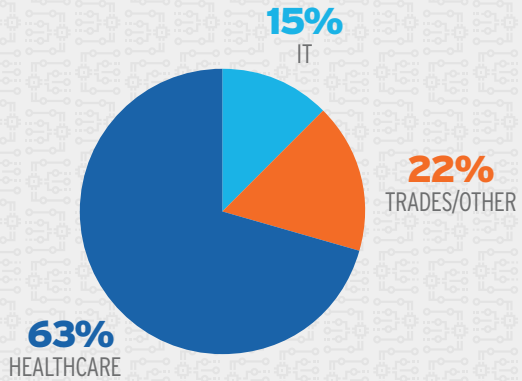

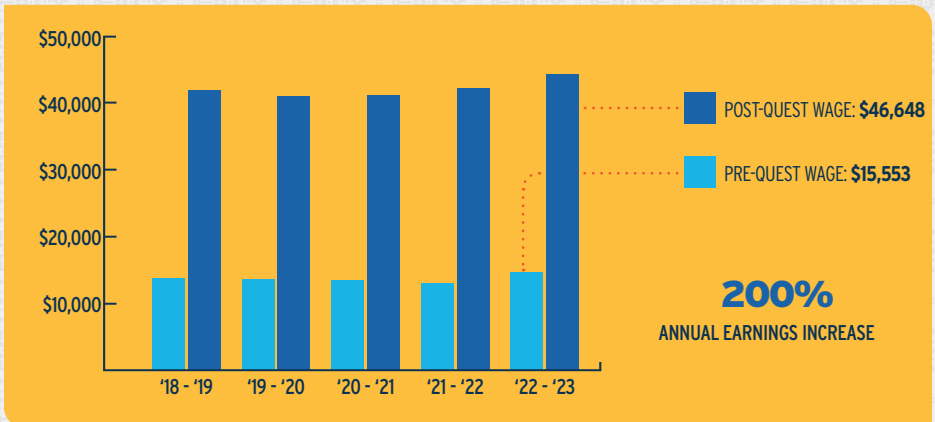

REGISTERED DENTAL ASSISTANT

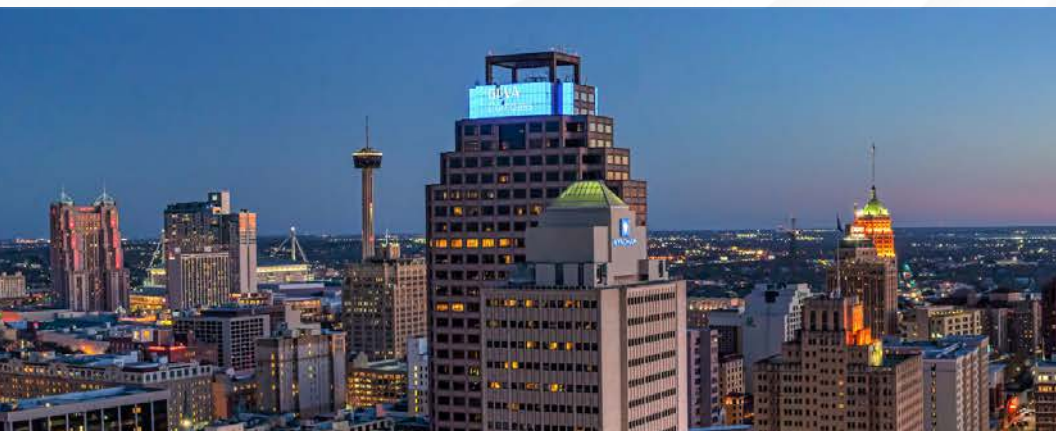

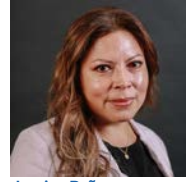
